School Grant Program

- 1. Provide an Application Summary (up to two pages) as attached and place it at the top of your application. It should provide a concise overview of your project.
- 2. In addition to the Application Summary, write a project description (up to five pages) describing the significance of the project, the steps you intend to take, and your project's prospects for success. Relate the proposal to LCEA's mission.
- 3. Outline a lesson plan and timetable (up to two pages).
- 4. Provide a detailed project budget and funding plan. Identify any other prospective funding sources and likelihood of financial support.
- 5. Identify the persons who will lead the project and provide their title and length of service at the school.
- 6. State how many students will be directly involved in the project and describe the roles they will play.
- 7. If the school received LCEA grants in the past, please identify the amounts, dates and purposes of such grants.
- 8. The application must be signed by the project leader and a school administrator.
- 9. Applications must be received by March 1 for grants to be made during the following school year. Expedited consideration may be available upon request.
- 10. Submit five (5) copies of the application to: Livingston County Environmental Association, P.O. Box 798, Pontiac, IL 61764. If you have questions, please call Judy Campbell at (815) 358-2729.

Please Note:

- Ordinarily, grants to any particular school are limited to a maximum of \$2,000 per year. All grants will be reviewed for justification and reasonableness in light of the achievability of the project's goals and educational value.
- Total grants to all schools will not exceed \$10,000 in any calendar year except in extraordinary circumstances.
